

DFW BEST LAKES

THE *Best* LAKES IN DFW

CEDAR CREEK LAKE

Located in Henderson and Kaufman Counties, Texas, 50 miles southeast of Dallas.

EAGLE MOUNTAIN LAKE

A reservoir in North Texas, formed by the damming of the West Fork of the Trinity River. The reservoir sits below Lake Bridgeport reservoir and above Lake Worth reservoir.

JOE POOL LAKE

A freshwater impoundment located in the southern part of the DFW Metroplex.

LAKE CYPRESS SPRINGS

A 3,461-acre reservoir in northeast Texas, approximately 90 miles east of Dallas.

LAKE GRANBURY

A North Texas reservoir near Granbury, Texas. It was created in 1969 and is one of three lakes damming the Brazos River.

LAKE GRAPEVINE

An American reservoir located in the North Texas region, approximately 20 miles northwest of Dallas and northeast of Fort Worth.

LAKE LAVON

A freshwater reservoir located in southeast Collin County, Texas, on the East Fork of the Trinity River near Wylie, off State Highway 78.

LAKE LEWISVILLE

A reservoir in North Texas on the Elm Fork of the Trinity River in Denton County near Lewisville.

LAKE O' THE PINES

A reservoir on Big Cypress Bayou, also known as Big Cypress Creek, chiefly in Marion County, Texas.

LAKE RAY HUBBARD

A freshwater impoundment located in Dallas, Texas in the counties of Dallas, Kaufman, Collin, and Rockwall, just north of the City of Forney.

LAKE TEXOMA

One of the largest reservoirs in the United States, the 12th largest US Army Corps of Engineers' lake, and the largest in USACE Tulsa District. Located close to Sherman.

POSSUM KINGDOM LAKE

A reservoir on the Brazos River located primarily in Palo Pinto County Texas.

RAY ROBERTS LAKE

An artificial 29,350-acre American reservoir located 10 miles north of Denton, Texas, between the cities of Pilot Point and Sanger.

WHITE ROCK LAKE

A reservoir located in north-east Dallas, Texas. The lake was formed by damming White Rock Creek. The lake covers 1,254 acres in the east Dallas community.
